


Properties Under Consideration for Designation in Proposed Reconstruction Era National Monument

- 1) Darrah Hall at Penn Center. Located on St. Helena Island, SC within the Penn Center National Historic Landmark District. Penn Center, Inc. has offered full ownership of the building to the National Park Service.
- 2) Brick Baptist Church. Located on St. Helena Island, SC within the Penn Center National Historic Landmark District. Brick Baptist Church has offered a historic preservation easement to the National Park Service.
- 3) Old Beaufort Firehouse. Located in Beaufort, SC, owners Billy and Paul Keyserling have offered full ownership to the National Park Service.
- 4) Camp Saxton Site, including Emancipation Oak grove, listed in the National Register of Historic Places. Emancipation Oak grove is located on the grounds of the U.S. Naval Support Facility Beaufort in Port Royal, SC.
- 5) Robert Smalls House. Located in Beaufort, SC, is currently designated a National Historic Landmark. It is already subject to an existing historic preservation easement which could form the basis of a National Park Service easement.
